CULTURAL DAY CAMPS



Cultural day camps offer a multitude of activities, both indoors and outdoors. Each morning, campers take part in the main activity of their selected camp, determined according to their age group. In the afternoon, all campers, regardless of their initial choice or age, will explore four artistic disciplines: theater, visual arts, music and dance. Supervised by a team of passionate animators who are experts in their field, they will enjoy dynamic, enriching and stimulating experiences.

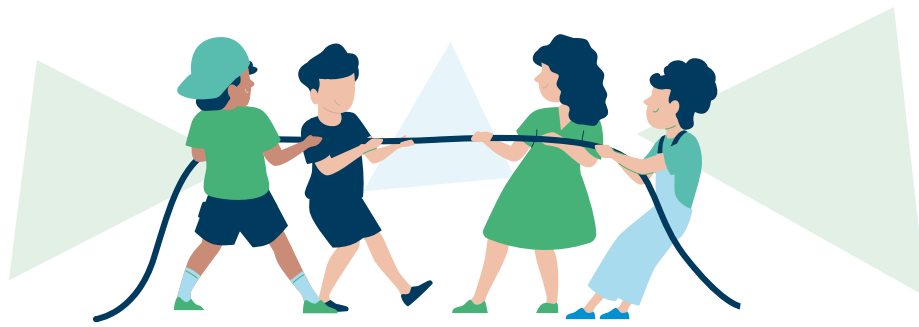

Alexandre-Bourgeois Sports Camp – Noël-Legault Community Centre
