RULES – PUBLIC SKATING

IT IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN:

- To practice figure skating or hockey / ringette
- To skate in the opposite direction or backwards
- To stop suddenly or dangerously
- To race or skate at excessive speed
- To form a chain or play tag
- To skate with someone on your back, in your arms, a sled or a stroller
- To sit on the boards of the rink as well as the ice surface
- To wear footwear other than skates on the rink
- To push or shove each other
- To skate with speed skates

ANY PERSON NOT CONFORMING TO THESE RULES MAY BE FORCED TO LEAVE THE RINK.

IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED:

- To wear a protective helmet
- That beginners use the section allotted to them
- That children be accompanied by an adult
