



Support Program for Seniors' Clubs





This program is specifically designed for seniors' clubs that are officially recognized by the City.

1.1 Objectives

- Provide support for the organization of leisure, sport, and outdoor recreational activities by seniors' clubs located in Pointe-Claire.
- Simplify the application process for seniors' clubs seeking support.
- Ensure support and fair treatment for all seniors' clubs.

1.2 Support

- \$200 grant for seniors' clubs with fewer than 100 members.
- \$400 grant for seniors' clubs with more than 100 members.

1.3 Eligibility Criteria

- The organization is a legally incorporated non-profit organization.
- It is administered by a democratically elected Board of Directors.
- Its headquarters are preferably in Pointe-Claire.
- It is well managed according to generally accepted principles.
- It is on the list of seniors' clubs that are recognized by the City.

1.4 How and When to Apply

Deadline: April 1 or September 1
