WHEREAS a notice of motion of the present by-law has been given beforehand.

CONSEQUENTLY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The second paragraph of section 9.13 of By-law number 2565 of the City of Pointe-Claire respecting traffic shall be replaced by the following:

« In the case of towing a vehicle which is parked contrary to any provision of the present by-law, the owner is liable of the penalty provided for in such a case, and can only recover possession of his vehicle upon payment of the actual towing costs and the actual storage costs, in addition to tickets issued or any other previous unpaid ticket.

1. The present by-law shall come into force according to the law.
