2021 ELECTOR'S GUIDE

IMPORTANT DATES

Mail delivery of voter registration notice, followed by the reminder card	Month of October
Revision of the list of electors	October 18, 19 and 21
Requesting to vote by mail*	No later than October 27
Advance polling	October 30 and 31
Voting at the office of the returning officer	November 2
Receipt of mail-in ballots by the office of the returning officer*	No later than November 5 at 4:30 p.m.
Polling day and announcement of the election results	November 7

* For eligible voters.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE?

Any person entered on the list of electors may vote. Voters are responsible for making sure their name is on the list. You can check if you are registered on the list of electors on the website of Élections Québec: www.electionsmunicipales.quebec/verify.



In October, a notice indicating the names of the persons entered on the electoral list at each address will be sent by mail. If your name is not on this list, you must go to the Board of Revisers to have your name entered.

To appear on the list of electors, you must meet the following conditions:



- ✓ You are at least 18 years old as of November 7, 2021.
- ✓ On September 1, 2021:
 - You are a natural person and a Canadian citizen (legal persons are not eligible to vote).
 - You are not in one of the situations leading to disqualification under the law.
- ✓ You meet one of the following conditions:
 - You have been domiciled in Pointe-Claire and in Québec for at least 6 months.
 - You have been the owner of an immovable or the occupant of a business establishment in Pointe-Claire for at least 12 months.
 - You have been a co-owner of an immovable or a co-occupant of a business establishment in Pointe-Claire for at least 12 months.

REVISION OF THE LIST OF ELECTORS

The Board of Revisers of the list of electors for the City of Pointe-Claire will sit at the City Hall Council Chamber (451 Saint-Jean Boulevard) on the following dates and times:

- ✓ October 18, 2021, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 2:30 to 5:30 p.m.
- ✓ October 19, 2021, from 2:30 to 5:30 p.m. and from 7 to 10 p.m.
- ✓ October 21, 2021, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2:30 to 5:30 p.m.

WHERE AND WHEN CAN YOU VOTE?

The addresses for advance polling and the polling day will be indicated on the reminder card that you will receive at your home in October 2021.

ADVANCE POLLING October 30 and 31, 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.
VOTING AT THE OFFICE OF THE RETURNING OFFICER November 2, 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.
POLLING DAY November 7, 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.



HOW TO VOTE BY MAIL

The following electors can vote by mail:

- ✓ people residing in a hospital, a residential long-term care centre, a rehabilitation centre or a private residence recognized by the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux
- ✓ people who are unable to travel for health reasons, and their caregivers
- ✓ between October 17 and 27, 2021, people who have been instructed to self-isolate by public health officials
- ✓ Eligible voters can request to vote by mail by contacting the office of the returning officer at 514-630-1300, ext. 1657, or by filling out the request form on the City's website, at www.pointe-claire.ca

A package including ballot papers will be mailed to them and must be returned to the office of the returning officer no later than Friday, November 5, 2021, at 4:30 p.m.

PROOF OF IDENTITY TO VOTE

To vote, you will be required to present one of the following proofs of identity:

- ✓ Health insurance card from the Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec
- ✓ Driver's licence
- ✓ Canadian passport
- ✓ Certificate of Indian Status
- ✓ Canadian Armed Forces identity card
