First-hand accounts of the Sir George Williams Riot, when students protested the administrations mishandling of racist accusations towards a professor.

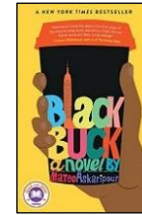

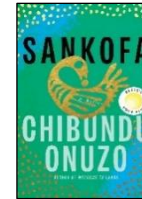

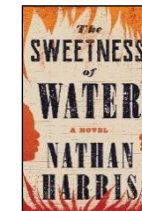

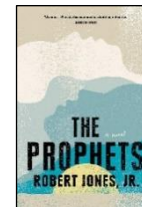

The stories of two brothers freed by the Emancipation Proclamation, and the forbidden romance between two Confederate soldiers.

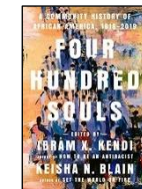

A forbidden union between 2 enslaved men on a Deep South plantation, the refuge they find in each other, and a betrayal that threatens their existence.

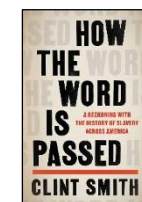
