

# 2023 ELECTOR'S GUIDE

## IMPORTANT DATES

Mail delivery of voter registration notice/reminder card	Month of March
Revision of the list of electors	April 3 and 4
Advance polling	April 16
Polling day and announcement of the election results	April 23



## WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE?

Any person entered on the list of electors in District 1 may vote. Voters are responsible for making sure their name is on the list.

In March, a notice indicating the names of the persons entered on the electoral list at each address will be sent by mail. If your name is not on this list, you must go to the Board of Revisors to have your name entered.

### To appear on the list of electors, you must meet the following conditions:

- ✓ You are at least 18 years old as of April 23, 2023.
- ✓ On February 1, 2023:
  - You are a natural person and a Canadian citizen (legal persons are not eligible to vote).
  - You are not in one of the situations leading to disqualification under the law.
  - You meet one of the following conditions:
    - You are a Pointe-claire resident and have been in Quebec for at least 6 months;
    - You have been the owner of an immovable or the occupant of a business establishment in District 1 for at least 12 months;
    - You have been a co-owner of an immovable or a co-occupant of a business establishment in District 1 for at least 12 months.



## REVISION OF THE LIST OF ELECTORS

The Board of Revisors of the list of electors of District 1 will sit at the City Hall Council Chamber (451 Saint-Jean Boulevard) on the following dates and times:

- ✓ April 3, 2023, from 1 to 5:30 p.m. and from 7 to 10 p.m.
- ✓ April 4, 2023, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

#### ADVANCE POLLING

April 16, 2023, 12 to 8 p.m.

#### POLLING DAY

April 23, 2023, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.

## PROOF OF IDENTITY TO VOTE

To vote, you will be required to present one of the following proofs of identity:

- ✓ Health insurance card from the Régie de l'assurance maladie du Québec (RAMQ)
- ✓ Driver's licence
- ✓ Canadian passport
- ✓ Certificate of Indian Status
- ✓ Canadian Armed Forces identity card
