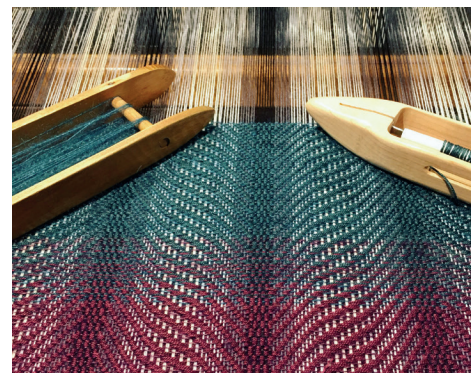
ENTRE LES LIGNES – WRITING MOUNTAINS
